Passports Required

A passport is needed for all US citizens arriving by air into Canada, as required by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. U.S. citizens, please allow for 6 weeks to get a first time passport. If you do not have your original birth certificate, then allow a lot more time. (No visa required for U.S. passport-holders to visit Canada.) U.S. citizens traveling by ground are not required to have a passport to visit Canada until 2008. The rules are changing often; you can find updates on the U.S. State Department website which also has information on how to apply for your passport:
